- Develop a summer school program for young professionals in heritage, offering specialized training and hands-on experience in heritage conservation and management.

### 3. Social Media Showcasing and the Portal of Heritage of the Islamic World:

- Develop a dynamic multimedia platform, and highlighted by the Portal of Heritage of the Islamic World, dedicated to showcasing the diversity and splendor of Islamic heritage.
